An independent buyer's review of the Genius Switch Audio Series — what the official page actually claims, who it suits, and how to decide.

Introduction: why this guide exists

If your attention drifts before you finish the first task of the day, you have probably already tried the obvious fixes — more coffee, a new planner, another productivity app. This guide looks at one option in the audio-training corner of that market: the Genius Switch Audio Series, sold online for \$39 with a 90-Day Money Back Guarantee.

Everything factual in this guide comes from the official product page. Where the page does not state something, we say so rather than filling the gap. Nothing here is medical, psychological or financial advice, and results differ from person to person.



The program is delivered as audio sessions you listen to — nothing to swallow, nothing to wear.

Who this guide is for

- You want a calm, low-effort routine rather than another habit system to maintain.
- You are comfortable with a digital-only product you stream or download.
- You want to know exactly what is claimed — and what is not — before paying.
- You want the refund window and the seller relationship spelled out up front.

How to use it

Read the criteria section first, then the overview. If the format does not fit your day, stop there — the guarantee is a safety net, not a reason to buy something that was never going to suit you.

What to look for in an audio brain-training program

The category is crowded and largely unregulated, so the buying decision comes down to a handful of checkable things rather than the size of the promise.

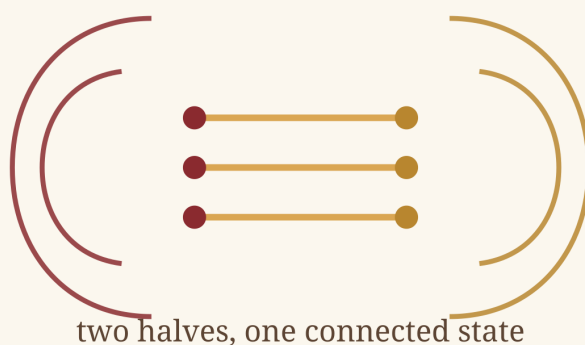
Criterion	What a good answer looks like
Format clarity	You know before paying whether it is audio, video, app or physical.
Delivery	Instant access after purchase; nothing to wait for in the post.
Effort per day	Fits into an existing slot — commute, walk, wind-down.
Refund window	Long enough to actually test the routine, not 7 days.
Claim discipline	Describes what it is designed to do, not what it guarantees.
Who sells it	A named marketplace handles billing and refunds.

Score any program against those six lines before you look at the price. A cheap program you never press play on is more expensive than a fair-priced one you finish.

Genius Switch: product overview

The official page presents Genius Switch as an audio series with the tagline “Rev Up Your Brain Power.” It is a digital product: you buy it, you get instant access, and you listen. Billing runs through ClickBank, which is the retailer of record for the offer.

The page describes the series as designed to help you use more of your brain, and cites published research on the corpus callosum and whole-brain or flow states. That is a description of the thinking behind the product — not evidence that any particular outcome will happen for you.



The official page frames the idea as connecting both hemispheres rather than training one skill.

Not stated on the official page

The page does not name a creator, publish a runtime or track count, show customer testimonials, or display a star rating. There is no subscription or recurring billing shown, and no physical product — it is a digital download. We will not invent any of those details here.

What the program is designed to offer

Framed as intentions from the official page, not promises:

- A whole-brain framing. The series is positioned around using more of your brain rather than drilling one narrow skill.
- Passive delivery. Listening is the entire activity — no worksheets, no streaks to maintain.
- Instant access. The offer page lists instant access, so you can start the same day.
- Quick-start bonuses. The page lists quick start bonuses as part of the package.
- A discounted entry price. \$39 today against listed regular prices of \$200, \$100 and \$49.
- A long test window. 90 days is enough to try the routine properly and still ask for a refund.



Digital delivery: access is granted immediately after purchase.

How it works in practice



Press play

Listen with headphones

Repeat daily

Buy, get instant access, then listen on a schedule that fits your day.

1. Purchase and get access. Checkout runs through ClickBank; access is delivered digitally straight after payment.

2. Pick your listening slot. Most people who stick with audio programs attach them to something that already happens daily — the commute, a walk, the first half hour at the desk, or the

wind-down before sleep.

3. Listen consistently and judge honestly. Give it a fair run inside the guarantee window, then decide. Use headphones in a quiet space, and never listen while driving or doing anything that needs your full attention.

A sensible safety note

Audio programs are not a treatment for any condition. If you have a diagnosed hearing, neurological or mental-health condition, talk to a qualified professional before adding anything new to your routine.

Pricing, access and the guarantee

Only one package is shown on the official page. Prices and terms are set by the merchant and can change at any time — always confirm on the merchant's own page before paying.

Pros and cons, honestly

Pros	Cons
Low price relative to the listed regular prices.	No named creator or credentials shown on the page.
90 days is a genuinely long test window.	No runtime or track count published, so you cannot judge the time commitment up front.
Digital delivery — start immediately, nothing to ship.	Digital-only will not suit anyone who wants something physical.
Effort per session is low: press play and listen.	No testimonials or ratings on the official page to weigh.
A named marketplace handles billing and refunds.	Outcomes are individual — nothing here is guaranteed for you.

Why someone chooses this over the alternatives

Most competing options ask for active work: a course to complete, an app to open daily, a subscription to keep paying. The distinguishing feature here is the opposite — a one-time \$39 digital purchase, delivered as audio, with no ongoing billing shown on the page and a 90-day window to change your mind.



Passive format: the session runs while you do something else.

That combination — a low one-time price, a passive format and a long guarantee — is the practical case for trying it. If you would rather have a structured course with an instructor and a syllabus, this is not that product, and no guarantee makes a mismatched format fit.

Common questions

What exactly do I get for \$39?

Access to the Genius Switch Audio Series. The official page also lists a special discount, instant access and quick start bonuses as part of the package. Nothing is shipped — it is a digital product.

Is there a subscription?

The official page shows a one-time price of \$39 and does not show any recurring billing. Confirm the terms on the merchant's checkout page before paying, since pricing is set by the merchant and can change.

How long is the refund window?

The page states a 90-Day Money Back Guarantee. Refunds are handled by ClickBank, the retailer of record for the offer.

How much time does it take each day?

The official page does not publish a runtime or track count, so we cannot state one. Plan to attach it to a slot you already have — a commute, a walk, or a wind-down.

Who created it?

No creator or author is named on the official page. If a named expert behind the program matters to you, treat that as a reason to be cautious.

Will it work for me?

Nobody can answer that in advance, and we will not pretend otherwise. The program is described as designed to help you use more of your brain; individual results vary. The 90-day window exists so you can test it at low risk.

Final recommendation

On the evidence available on the official page, the Genius Switch Audio Series looks like a reasonable low-risk experiment for someone who wants a passive, audio-first routine and is comfortable with a digital-only product. It is not a good fit if you need a named expert, a published curriculum, or a physical item.

Our suggestion: check the current price and terms on the merchant's own page, and if the format matches how you would realistically use it, use the guarantee window as it is intended — as a real trial period.

A five-point check before you buy

- Confirm today's price and what is included on the merchant's own page.
- Confirm the refund window and how to request a refund through ClickBank.
- Decide which daily slot you will actually listen in — write it down.
- Set a date inside the guarantee window to review honestly whether to keep it.
- Remember it is digital-only: nothing arrives in the post.
